- Weaned mid-November and put onto a TMR which consisted of 51.5% corn silage, 19% corn grain, 16% DDGS and 13% second cut alfalfa and mineral (with rumensin)
- Verified Beef Production Plus and BIXS enrolled, eligible for Cargill's Canadian Beef Sustainability Acceleration Program.
- Steers will be Age verified
- Vaccinated with BoviShield Gold One Shot, Ultrabac 7/Somubac and Cylence in June. Booster vaccines and Ivermectin pour on given post weaning in Mid-November.
- No Implants.
- FOB Farm
- No Stags or Horns, steers are knife cut.
- Calves performed well with no health issues.
- A-8 Ranch has invested in a good breeding program that features high quality Simmental and Angus genetics that contributes to good deep-bodied calves with an excellent hair coat.
- We are also adding only top end replacement heifers to our cow herd.

- Cattle descriptions are provided by Tyler Slawinski, Auctioneer. Cattle viewing is encouraged. Additional videos may be available upon request.

- All calves were taken off feed for 12 hours and pre weighed on a non-certified single animal scale and sorted into lots. Cattle weighed on March 1st. Sale weights are expected to be close to the bid weights on sale day. **Depending on pick up dates, calf weights may vary slightly due to gain from sale day.**

- **Please register 24 hours prior to the sale.** For online bidding, register online at <http://gladstoneauctionmart.com> or (Videos can be viewed on YouTube) –

- Calves will be weighed on a **legal for trade farm scale** with **4%** shrink. A representative of Gladstone Auction Mart will be present for weighing upon request of the buyer.

- **Cattle will be taken off feed for 12 hours minimum and weighed in the A.M.**

- **A-8 Ranch Cattle** can be weighed 1-3 days before departure to allow the cattle to go back on feed to be comfortable before a long journey.

A-8 Ranch Cattle can be fed for an additional time frame to accommodate the successful bidder.

- There will be no charge for feed for up to 5 days.

- A representative of the successful bidder should be present at the time of weighing.

- Numbers and colors of lots may vary slightly.

- **No pulls allowed.**
