Recall Description

The Electronic Unit (ECU) for the Supplemental Restraint System (SRS) in these vehicles could have been manufactured with integrated circuits (ICs) that are susceptible to internal short circuiting when exposed to certain electrical noise from various vehicle electrical components. If internal short circuiting occurs, the front airbag(s) and/or seat belt pretensioner(s) could inadvertently deploy. An airbag that deploys inadvertently can, under some circumstances, increase the risk of injury and the possibility of a crash.

Remedy

Toyota will install a sub-wire harness (filter), if not previously installed as part of Safety Recall 190, and replace the SRS ECU

Recall Description

Due to the age of your vehicle, if the airbag deploys, a part inside is more likely to explode and shoot sharp metal fragments which could cause SERIOUS INJURY or DEATH to the driver or passengers.

Remedy

Toyota dealers will replace the front passenger airbag inflator or airbag assembly with a new one that is not manufactured by Takata and which is of a different design, at no charge to the vehicle owner.
