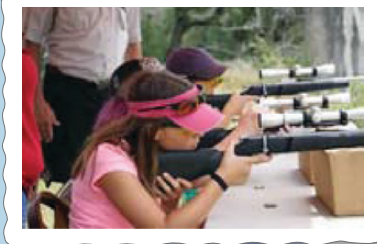
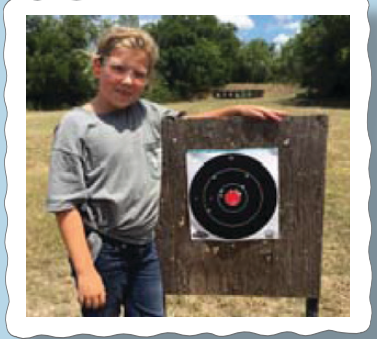

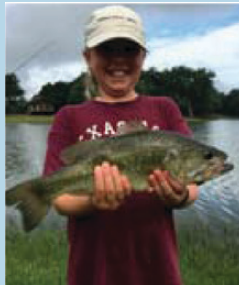

This past year we combined our Fishing and Fly Fishing Camps to expose ALL Campers to Fly Fishing and Fly Tying and then gave them the option of fishing with Conventional Tackle, or Fly Fishing Tackle ... which resulted in one of our Campers Fly Fishing for the 1st time, with one of his very own hand-tied flies, and catching the New Bastrop Lake Record Common Grass Carp. 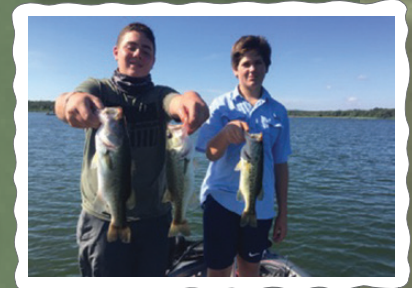

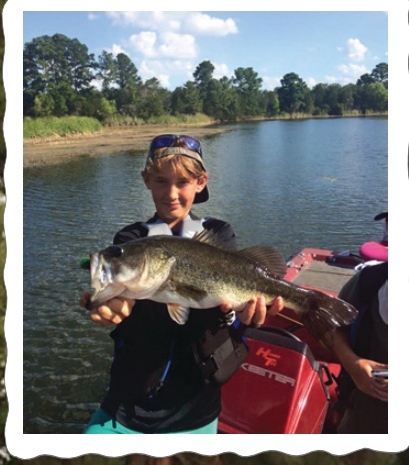


FISHING EQUIPMENT

BOYS SALTWATER FISHING CAMPS

The Texas Coast is like **NO OTHER**, stretching **367 miles** as the crow flies along a gentle arc that makes up nearly 1/3 of the coastline along the Gulf of Mexico. Follow the actual shoreline and you will traverse **3,300 miles** of barrier islands, bays and estuaries where the many rivers of Texas empty into the Gulf of Mexico. You could spend a lifetime exploring it, and many have tried. Our **Saltwater Fishing Camps** are located just south of Corpus Christi in a large house off of Laguna Shores Road that parallels the Intracoastal Canal, the aquatic highway that runs from Florida all the way to the tip of Texas. The portion that we host our **Saltwater Fishing Camps** on is home to some of the **BEST** fishing for Redfish, Speckled Trout, Drum and Flounder in the country. No other Camp that we host has created more interest and excitement than our **Saltwater Fishing Camps**, which is why they are always the first Camps to fill up each summer. With Local Guides and Professional Fishermen guiding our Campers in one of the most popular fishing destinations in the US, you can see why Campers come back year after year to take part in Activities such as:

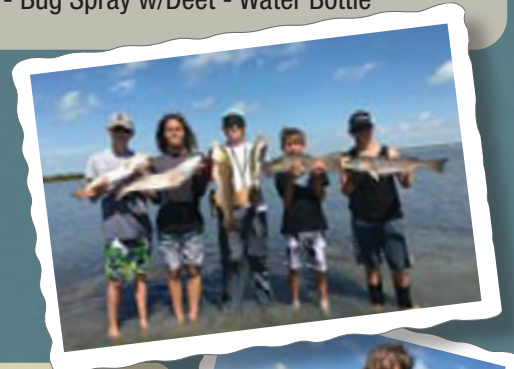
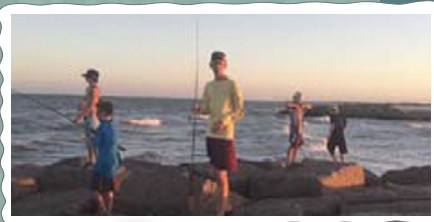
Optional Activities

Our Saltwater Fishing Camps are our most popular, and for good reason. There is not another Fishing Camp, freshwater or saltwater, that packs as much into just one week. Below is an idea of what your Camper will experience on Texas' Gulf Coast with **Outdoor Texas Camps**:

- 1. Offshore Fishing Trip:** Our first day will be spent offshore fishing for **Red Snapper, King Mackerel, Atlantic Sharp-Nosed Shark, Black-Tip Shark** and more. We head offshore out of Port Aransas from **Capt. Kelly's Deep Sea Headquarters** on our own boat. It's an 8 hour trip, so we'll be back to the dock around 3:00pm...tired with sore muscles, sore hands, plenty of fillets and loads of smiles.
- 2. Flounder Giggling Trip:** Each group of 4 Campers will spend a night with **Capt. Greg of Giggling with Greg Guide Service**. They'll meet Capt. Greg around 9:00pm and head out to the flats. Most nights end around 1:30am with a limit of Flounder, a limit of Drum, maybe some Stingrays (Capt. Greg sells them to shark fishermen) and a lifetime of memories.
- 3. Bayfishing Trip:** Each group of 4 Campers will spend a 1/2 day in the Bay with one of our Bay Fishing Guides. Campers will leave the dock around 7:00am and fish for Speckled Trout, Redfish, Drum and Flounder, arriving back to the dock around noon.
- 4. Overnight Cabin Fishing Trip:** Each group of 4 Campers will head south on the intracoastal canal around 7:00pm to a Baffin Bay Cabin off the King Ranch Shoreline where they'll stay overnight. When the sun goes down, the lights get turned on, and the fish start biting. The Camp Record is 778 Speckled Trout in **1** night.
- 5. Additional Fish Related Activities:** In addition to all the above, Campers will Wade Fish, Jetty Fish, Surf Fish, learn knots and saltwater rigging for live, dead and artificials, and Yes... even have time at the beach. On Friday we host a Hard-Head Tournament...Largest Fish gets bragging rights and a Whataburger Gift-Card.

WEEKLY SALTWATER FISHING CAMP SCHEDULE

Our Saltwater Fishing Camp Schedule is hard to describe. Waking up early and staying up late, while moving around between Port Aransas and Corpus Christi fishing all day, makes for a hectic week. As you see below, our Saltwater Fishing Camps are less like a Camp and more like hanging out all week with your buddies and fishing all day/night, which is why the Campers love it so much!!!

Monday: All Campers will wake up at 5:30am so we can get to Deep Sea Headquarters in Port Aransas by 6:30, and on the boat by 6:45am. We'll be offshore all day fishing for snapper, kingfish, ling, barracuda, blackfin tuna and shark, then back at the dock by 3:00pm, and the Lodge by 4:30. We'll all have dinner together, then one group of 4 will head to the Floating Barge at 7:00pm to overnight and fish, while another will meet the Flounder Gigging Guide at 9:00pm and be off the water around 1:30am. The 2 groups that don't go to the Floating Barge or Flounder Gigging will go Wade Fishing and Jetty Fishing.

Tuesday – Thursday: Campers will rotate between Wade Fishing, Bay Fishing, Jetty Fishing, Knot Tying, learning Baits, Lures & Rigging Techniques, Casting and learning how to throw a Cast Net. Those that didn't go to the Floating Barge or Flounder Gigging on Monday night will rotate through those activities during the week.

Friday: On Friday the Campers get to sleep in a bit, if they'd like. Each group of 4 can then choose whether to go Wade Fishing, Jetty Fishing or head to the Beach. We finish off the week with a Hard Head Fishing Tournament after the Friday Night Fish Fry. Longest fish wins bragging rights, some swag and some gift cards.



STAFF and INSTRUCTORS

The success of **Outdoor Texas Camps** is due to its dedicated Staff and Instructors. 80% of our Counselors (we call them Guides) and Interns (the Crew) are made up of past Campers, as it is our goal to not only develop hunting, fishing and outdoor skills, but Character and Leadership as well. 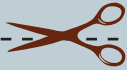

Some of the most Frequently Asked Questions from Parents:

Can my Camper bring his/her Cell Phone?

Hunting Camps... We **DO NOT** allow Campers to bring their cell phones to any of our Hunting Camps. At our Hunting Camps the Campers have private rooms, 2 to a room, and it is impossible for us to monitor their cell phone activity. We also begin our days at 7:00am, are active all day out in the sun and heat, and end our days at 8:30pm with lights off at 10:00pm. It would be hard to ensure the health, welfare and safety of our Campers and Staff if we allowed our Campers access to their cell phones and watching shows, youtube videos or inappropriate material at all hours of the night.

Fishing Camps... **We DO** allow Campers to bring their cell phones to our Fishing Camps to take photos of fish caught, and as a safety factor when out on the boat with Guides. However, at all other times the cell phones will be under the control of their Counselor.

Communication with Your Camper... If you need to reach your Camper, or they “need” to reach you, you will be provided with their Counselors cell phone #, and have the Camp Director’s as well.

Can my Camper bring an Electronic Game (ie Game-Boy) to Camp?

ABSOLUTELY NOT... All Electronic Games, not on their Cell Phones, will be picked up and given back after Camp.

Can my Camper bring his/her Rifle, Shotgun or Pistol?

ABSOLUTELY NOT!!! OUTDOOR TEXAS CAMPS will provide ALL rifles, shotguns, Pistols and Ammo. Dury’s Guns, a local San Antonio Gun Shop, cleans and maintains all of our Firearms to ensure that they are in Good Working Condition. We cannot be sure of the same with a firearm or ammo that is brought from home by a Camper.

Can my Camper bring his/her own Bow, Arrows and/or Fishing Rod?

Yes! Your Camper can bring his own Bow, Arrows and/or Fishing Rod. However, we require that all personal Bows & Arrows be brought in either a hard or soft case. Also, please make sure that your Campers Bow, Arrows and/or Fishing Rod are properly labeled with their name.

Can my Camper bring his/her own Snacks?

NO!!! Not only does it create a mess in the rooms and cabins when they attempt to “hide the evidence”, but it attracts bugs and additional work for those cleaning up the rooms in between Camps. It also creates a problem between those that follow the rules, and those that don’t when something goes missing, or one Camper chooses to share with some of his/her campmates, but not others.

Can my Camper receive Mail and/or Packages at Camp?

Yes! We prefer that all Mail and/or packages be brought to Camp the day of your Campers arrival and be given to the Camp Director, or Counselor, to be distributed as instructed. Because our offices are in San Antonio, but our Camps are 1-5 hours away, and sometimes in remote locations, Mail and/or Packages may not be delivered to your Camer by the time he/she goes home.

Does my Camper need to have a Fishing License?

Probably Not! The State of Texas only requires a Fishing Lincense if you are 17 years of age, or older.

How do I bring my Campers daily/seasonal medications, and who will dispense them?

All daily/seasonal medications need to be brought in ziplock bag(s), properly labeled with your Campers name, with a detailed typed daily schedule. All medications must be delivered to our Camp Director and will be dispensed as directed on your detailed typed schedule.

Does Outdoor Texas Camps have an on-call Medical Director?

Yes! We have an on-call Medical Director that is committed to answering our calls 24 hours a day. In addition, we have relationships with area EMT’s at each of our Camp locations.
