2026 SCOTLAND HUNT DONATIONS

Dear Safari Club President and Fundraising Chairman,

For 47 years, International Adventures Unlimited has donated hunts on all six continents that allow big game hunting in order to support Safari Club International in their fundraising efforts. We have no doubt donated more than any single donor in those decades.

We have been taking people to **Scotland** for thirty five years now, and have donated a portion of these **Scotland** hunts to chapter fundraisers throughout that time period. They have been highly successful auction items for those chapters, as well as prestigious offerings enhancing the class of their chapter's banquets. With this letter, I am enclosing some additional information on both the Scotland Spring Roebuck and Fall Red Stag hunts that we are offering your chapter this year. Please pass this information on to your fundraising committee after you have had a chance to review the enclosed material regarding the hunts.



Our spring **Roebuck** hunt takes place from the middle of May to early July where we have exclusive hunting rights on some of the most famous and prestigious estates in Scotland encompassing over 60 estates exceeding a million acres. On the following pages, you will find the details of this package. This comprehensive package we are offering includes all airport transfers, all meals and lodging at the luxurious Loch Kinord Hotel, in addition to the complete 1 on 1 hunting package and trophy fee for **two mature bucks**. Any additional bucks may be harvested for a \$175 outing fee plus \$950 trophy fee including guide and transfer to and from the hunting estate. Spectacular touring opportunities when your guest is done hunting are also included. In addition I will also provide the field preparation of their trophies and oversee the capping, turning ears and lips, fleshing, salting, and drying by one of our professional

taxidermists on location at cost in addition to overseeing the crating, shipping, exporting, and clearing of their trophies in 60-90 days after the conclusion of our hunt, also on a cost basis, which is a huge savings.

In previous years, many chapters have sold this hunt for \$10,000 and more...two recently went for \$18,000 each (over double retail), which made for quite a profitable donation. To increase the value of this donation even more, we are allowing the successful bidder to bring additional hunters with them at a \$1,000.00 discount off of normal retail including airfare, bringing the total value of this donation to well over **\$10,000.00**.

It is important to note that the only way an individual can hunt on these spectacular estates is by purchasing this hunt from International Adventures Unlimited. Because we only offer a limited number of these packages, this is a very exclusive and prestigious experience. Some European Roebuck hunts are offered at other auctions for \$20,000 and more.

We are also offering your chapter a **Red Stag** hunt in the fall. The package includes the harvesting of one hill stag or the option as 90% of our guests elect to do, and that is to trade in their hill stag and upgrade this hunt on a cost basis to one of the truly outstanding estate stags that can be found on our properties in Scotland. This upgrade provides the successful bidder a trophy costing half to a fourth of what a comparable trophy would cost elsewhere.

This donated package also includes all airport transfers, meals and lodging at the luxurious Lands of Loyal Hotel, an old 18th Century Duke's estate, in addition to a 1 on 1 hunt package for a hill stag for which there is **no trophy fee**. However, the option 90% of our guests elect to do is to upgrade their trophy quality. We will also



take care of the field preparation of their trophies plus the final preparation overseeing the caping, turning ears and lips, fleshing, salting, and drying by one of our professional, on site taxidermists, as well as crating, shipping, exporting, and the clearing of their trophies at cost in 60 to 90 days after the conclusion of our hunt.

To increase the value even more, if the successful bidder wants to bring another hunter with him (or her), we will discount additional hunters by \$1,000 off of normal retail, bringing the total value of this donation to well over **\$10,000** excluding the **tremendous additional value** of our upgrade stags.

To help cover some expenses, we request a \$4,9500.00 minimum bid to us on either hunt, In years past, we may have provided the option for a chapter to include international airfare in their auction items. However, with the popularity of frequent flyer programs, we are finding the majority of the chapters prefer to let their successful bidders book their own airline tickets in order to receive the donations for the above minimum bids.

You must stress to your chapter that the *true* value of this donation is that we are allowing the successful bidder the possibility of taking a Safari Club record book trophy estate stag at a fraction of what an individual would expect to pay anywhere in the world. Our incredible herd was started over 50 years ago, with numerous top ten record book trophies being taken as well as Number 1 rankings in the record book.

It is important for you to know that I am not a booking agent. I am on all of these hunts personally hosting the successful bidder from your chapter, making sure that his (or her) hunt goes exactly the way it has been presented. This offering is not a gimmick. The quality of these trophies, coupled with the personal attention provided to both our hunters and non-hunters sets this donation apart.

If your successful bidder on either hunt, brings non-hunters along, they will have a great experience touring castles, historical sites, and shopping at a cost of \$3,450.00. That package includes full roundtrip coach airfare as per our company policy, airport transfers, their stay at our luxurious 18th century duke's estate, meals, admissions to castles, etc.

The donations we offer not only help Safari Club International with their on going conservation and education programs, but they also provide members of your chapter with an exclusive and memorable hunting experience, adding a real touch of class to your fundraising efforts.

These hunts can be taken in 2026 subject to availability, or a future year as agreed upon with your successful bidder. If your chapter decides to take us up on one or both of these offerings, you must let us know so I can earmark the appropriate hunt (or hunts) for your chapter from the very limited number we have available. We will then send you a full, detailed marketing package on the hunt which will answer any and all questions for you and your successful bidder. This will be in an attractive book with many pictures you can lay out at the fundraising banquet plus flyers that can be handed out or placed on the banquet tables.

We are sending donor forms with this letter to document our intentions to help your chapter, which must be completed, signed, and returned to verify and document your intentions and agreement to the terms of this donation.

Looking forward to working with you in furthering Safari Club International's education and conservation efforts, and providing outstanding hunting experiences for your chapter's membership.
