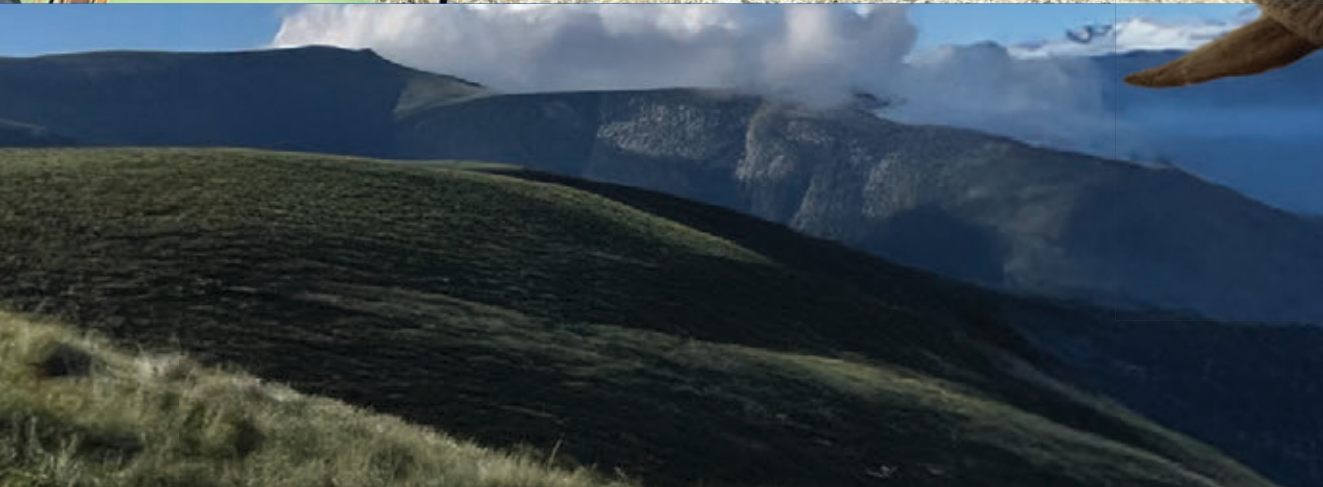

The thatched lodges and outdoor campfires create an exciting atmosphere during your stay. As you arise from your slumber each morning, you will be met with exquisite mountain views and

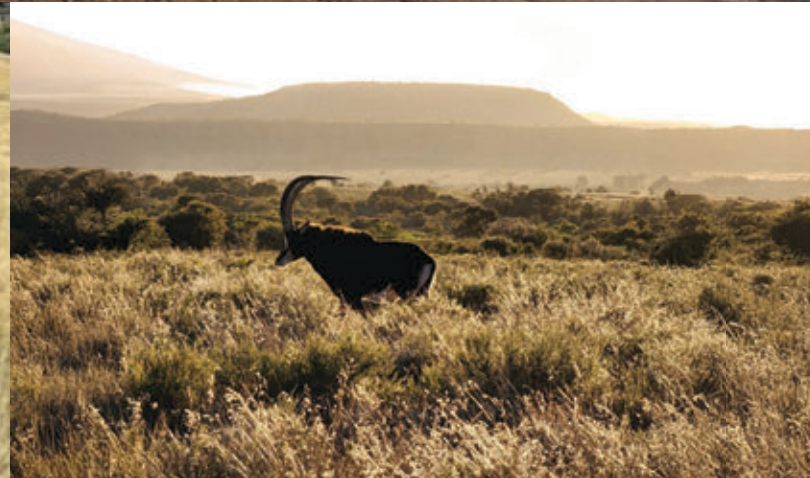
